The Yagi antenna is pointed directly at the Mobile tower to provide the best gain. Used if you have 1-2 bars of service outside. The Omni antenna picks up signal in a 360 degree radius. Good if you have 3-4 bars outside and less signal inside.

As the Yagi antenna is not that much more expensive you can play it safe and go straight to that option or if you have the option to go with the Omni and have 3-4 bars outside this will just come down to how you want the antenna to look on your roof.
