NEC SL1100 – Program Night Service Button (Mode Switching)

Purpose

This guide explains how to program a Night Service (mode switching) button on an NEC SL1100 handset so staff can easily switch between Day and Night modes.

Prerequisites

- NEC SL1100 system operational
- Handset with an available flexible key
- Administrator/system phone (typically ext. 101)
- Knowledge of which button will be assigned

Procedure – Step-by-Step

- 1. Press Speaker.
- 2. Dial 751 (enter Key Programming mode). Display: KEY PROGRAM
- 3. Press the flexible button to program (e.g. Button 24). Display: KEY24
- 4. Dial 090. Display: NIGHT SERVICE 0
- 5. Listen for confirmation beep.
- 6. Press Speaker to exit programming.

Testing

Press the newly programmed button and confirm the system switches into Night Mode based on the site's call flow.

Notes & Tips

- If no beep is heard, repeat the steps.
- Programming overwrites any function previously assigned to that button.
- Night Mode routing is configured in system programming—not the handset.
